Instructions for publication of the proceedings volume

to appear in the *Aegaeum* series in September 2017

Manuscripts should be sent to Robert Laffineur, at the e-mail address [r.laffineur@ulg.ac.be](mailto:r.laffineur@ulg.ac.be) before **30 September 2016**. Contributors are requested to comply with that date in order to meet the deadlines for issuing the volume.

The text has to be submitted in Microsoft Word format (.doc or .docx). A paper copy is not necessary. The file should be limited to **10 pages** at *Aegaeum* standards. For the number of signs and lines, please refer to the last two proceedings volumes of PHYSIS and METAPHYSIS, respectively #37 and #39 in the series. The font used in the printed volumes is Baskerville, font size 11 points for text and 10 points for footnotes. Please use this font directly if you can have access to it. Acknowledgements are to be included in a \* footnote at the end of the title.

Illustrations will be limited to unpublished or indispensable material. Photographs and line drawings must be identified in a 'List of illustrations', following the text, and providing full captions and copyright information. If a specific enlargement is necessary, e.g. for a map or a site plan, please indicate the desired size (full A4 page, half A4 page) in a file of comments, where you have also the possibility to specify which illustrations have to be reproduced in colour. Tables have to be submitted as Microsoft Excel files.

Bibliographical quotations in the footnotes should conform strictly to the *ars citandi* used in the *Aegaeum* series (see examples below). Authors are requested to avoid the Harvard quotation system (Betancourt 1992, 235). Mss using that system will be returned to the authors for correction. References to books or articles already quoted *supra* in a footnote will be cited as follows: AUTHOR (*supra* n. 00) 000. Abbreviations for periodicals are those listed regularly in *Bulletin de Correspondance Hellénique*. References which are frequently quoted will be abbreviated by the editors and a list of those general abbreviations will appear at the beginning of the volume, as well as on the .pdf offprints.

Authors will receive one proof only (in .pdf format), to check and return in a delay of one month. The mock-up of illustrations will not be included with the proof, but it will be prepared by the editors with the usual care.

Authors will have the possibility to purchase a copy of the proceedings volume at a reduced price (to be announced later) and will receive a .pdf offprint of their paper.
